CLEARLY NAMING ITEMS

Please can you ensure that bags, lunchboxes, drinks bottles, coats and any other items that are brought in are <u>clearly</u> <u>labelled with your child's name</u>.

REMINDERS

Cocktail sticks

For those children who attend lunch club, please can we remind parents not to put cocktail sticks in their child's lunch.

Contents of childrens' bags

The childrens' bags hang in communal cloakrooms which are accessible to all children. Could we therefore please ask that nothing other than spare clothes and any comforters are put in the bags. Please avoid items such as hand gels, creams, food, and sweets. All medication should be handed to a member of staff.

OUTSIDE PLAY WEATHER

Please dress children appropriately once the colder weather appears, as we aim to go outside every day. Children will need hats and gloves as well as coats.

We aim to keep the school open even during severe weather (e.g. snow). However, if you are unsure, please call one of the contact numbers given here.

WORKING TOGETHER

Observation sheets are available for parents; these enable you to share any achievements with us or give details of any milestones your child has reached over the half term holidays.

READING SCHEME

Our Reading Scheme is introduced to children who will be starting primary school in September 2021. Children in the Butterfly Room will be phased in according to their age with most children engaged by Christmas.

We would be grateful if you could return your child's reading folder on their allocated reading day each week so they can continue their phonic learning.

ABSENCE / SICKNESS / COVID-19
