PRIMARY SCHOOL INTAKE 2021

Please note that for children born between 1st September 2016 and 31st August 2017, the application deadline for the 2021 Reception intake is **Friday 15th January 2021**.

The online system is available via the home page of www.bromley.gov.uk. The Admissions Team public number (020 8313 4044), which is open from 12 - 3pm on weekdays only, provides parents with advice about home-to-school distances, how the system works and making realistic preferences.

WORKING TOGETHER

Observation sheets are available for parents. These enable you to share any achievements with us or give details of any milestones your child has reached over the Christmas holidays. Please ask a member of staff if you would like a sheet.

ADDITIONAL MEDICATION

If any creams, inhalers, or medication are in children's bags, please let a member of staff know so they can be stored safely. PLEASE DO NOT BRING IN SANITISING "ANTIBAC" GEL.

If we need to administer any of the above, we will also require you to complete a "Medication Form" giving details of dosage and timings – these can be obtained from any member of staff.

CLEANING AND HAND WASHING

We would like to assure you that we are doing everything we possibly can to minimise the spread of Covid 19 in our pre-school. The children have got used to washing their hands many times during the sessions.

All our equipment is washed after every session and the premises and furniture are

ABSENCE / SICKNESS

cleaned before we start each day.

We are required by Ofsted to monitor children's attendance therefore, please let us know if your child is going to be away from pre-school for any reason.

If your child has been sick or has had diarrhoea, please keep them off for a **MINIMUM of 48 hours** after their symptoms have stopped.

IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

In the interest of child safety, we will not let any child go home with anyone other than the nominated person unless we have been given prior notice. A photograph is always a good idea or a password if it is someone not known to us. Please remember we have not always met dads or grandparents and therefore they may be unfamiliar to us. Please ensure we have up to date mobile numbers so that we can contact you in an emergency.

REMINDERS

- Please ensure that all items of your child's clothing is labelled – this includes hats, scarves and gloves.
- Please remember to label lunch boxes and drinks bottles with your child's name.
- Please ensure that your child's lunch box is healthy, that there are no products containing nuts or sesame, and that there is no chocolate included.
