IMPORTANT SAFETY NOTICE

In the interest of child safety, we will not let any child go home with anyone other than the nominated person unless we have been given prior notice. Please use the password which was advised to us in your Registration Form if someone not known to us...and please remember we have not always met dads or grandparents and therefore they will be unfamiliar to us.

LABELLING

Please ensure that all water bottles, lunch boxes and bags and backpacks are labelled clearly.

It is also important that sweatshirts are labelled as, with the warmer weather approaching, these will be taken off during the session.

SUMMER OUTSIDE PLAY

Our curriculum encourages free flow from the inside to the outside area throughout the morning and afternoon sessions.

Therefore, please supply your child with a named hat and apply sun cream to them before the session starts. We will only re-apply sun cream to those children who are attending all day and for these children, please bring in sun cream clearly marked with their name.

PRIMARY SCHOOL PLACES

Bromley resident applicants, accepted as 'on time' will be sent a notification of offer email on Monday 17th April 2022 from 5.30pm. It is planned that a letter will also be mailed the same day (by first class post) confirming the school offer and the options available if this wasn't a first preference offer.

We would be grateful if you could let Catherine or Su know which primary school your child will be attending in September as soon as it is confirmed. We will then be able to send a copy of your child's final report to their new school for information.

HOME LEARNING IN THE BUTTERFLY ROOM

During the summer term, those children who are approaching their 4th birthday and leaving in July will be given their home learning folder.

You will be given a specific day when the folder can be brought in and the book / worksheets changed.

Please remember, these are not compulsory and it is not 'homework' but an opportunity for us to share ideas and information.

ABSENCE / SICKNESS

We are required by Ofsted to monitor children's attendance therefore please let us know if your child is going to be away from pre-school for any reason.

If your child has been sick or has had diarrhoea, please keep them off for a **MINIMUM of 48 hours** after their symptoms have stopped.
