Children in the Caterpillar Room who do not usually attend on a Thursday should be brought to school for 9.20am. Having dropped the children off at the door, parents/carers should then proceed to the outside area (behind the Bowling Green) and wait for the event to begin.

ADVISING ABSENCE

OFSTED require us to contact parents if we do not receive a phone call in the morning telling us your child will not be in Pre-School that day. Therefore, please phone any of the numbers given to advise sickness on the first day of absence and give us notice of holidays.

END OF YEAR REPORTS

During the week commencing 19th June, you will receive your child's report – you will receive **one** copy which you must sign and return to pre-school by Friday 30th June

For those children who start new schools in September, we will copy your signed report and then one will be sent to your chosen school to help the teachers familiarise themselves with your child, and one will be kept in your child's Leavers Folder.

In order to maintain and improve the quality of care and education we provide, parents of children who are going to primary school in September will also receive a short Leavers Questionnaire. Please take time to consider what you think we have done well and areas you believe we could improve and then return the questionnaire to us by Friday 7th July.

SUMMER OUTSIDE PLAY AND LABELLING

Please supply your child with a named hat and apply sun cream to them before the session starts. We will only re-apply sun cream to those children who are attending all day and for these children, please bring in sun cream clearly marked with their name.

Please also remember to label your child's water bottle and their sweatshirts as these are often taken off during the session.
