# **RAINBOW DROPS**

We are introducing Rainbow Drop characters to help children understand their emotions and learn how to regulate themselves through stories and discussion. There are 4 rainbow drops linked to different emotions:

Red - angry, upset, cross

Blue - sad, tired, lonely

Yellow - worried, frustrated, confused

Green - happy, calm, relaxed

These link to the Zones of Regulation which are adopted by most primary schools in Bromley. Please speak to Catherine or Su if you would like more information.

# END OF YEAR REPORTS

During the week commencing 30<sup>th</sup> June, you will receive your child's report.

For those children who start new schools in September, you can keep the report and put it in your child's folder when you receive it at the Leavers' Concert.

For those children who are coming back to the Pavilion in September, you will receive 2 copies, one of which you must sign and return to pre-school by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July.

In order to maintain and improve the quality of care and education we provide, parents of children who are going to primary school in September will also receive a short Leavers Questionnaire. Please take time to consider what you think we have done well and areas you believe we could improve and then return the questionnaire to us by Friday 11<sup>th</sup> July.

# SUMMER OUTSIDE PLAY AND LABELLING

Please supply your child with a named hat and apply sun cream to them before the session starts. We will only re-apply sun cream to those children who are attending all day and for these children, please bring in sun cream clearly marked with their name. It would also be helpful if you could take hats out of bags.

Please also remember to label your child's water bottle and their sweatshirts as these are often taken off during the session.
